

A bolt cutter is a heavy-duty hand tool with long handles and short, hardened steel jaws. It uses compound hinges to multiply user force, making it easy to cut through thick metal bolts, chains, padlocks, rebar, and wire mesh. Prices typically range from ₹300 for mini sizes to over ₹1,500 for professional models.

Common Sizes & Uses

- **8 to 12 inch (Mini):** Best for light tasks like cutting small wires, nails, and threaded rods.
- **14 to 18 inch (Medium):** Good for medium-duty fencing, mesh, and softer chains.
- **24 to 36 inch (Heavy Duty):** Built for thick padlocks, hardened chains, and heavy construction rebar. [
